

A LESSON of TEAMWORK from GEESE.

As each bird flaps its wings, by flying in a V-formation, the whole flock adds 71% flying range than if each bird flew alone.

LESSON: People who share a common direction and sense of teamwork can get where they are going quicker and easier because they are travelling on the thrust of one another.

Whenever a goose falls out of formation, it quickly gets back into formation to take advantage of the "LIFTING POWER" of the bird immediately in front.

LESSON: If we have as much sense of a goose, we will step into formation with those who are headed where we want to go.

When the lead goose gets tired, it rotates back into formation and another goose flies at the point position.

LESSON: It pays to take turns doing the hard tasks and sharing leadership, interdependent with each other.

The geese in formation honk from behind to encourage those up front to keep their speed.

LESSON: We need to make sure our honking from behind is encouraging.....not something less helpful.

When a goose gets sick or wounded, two geese drop out of formation to help and protect. They stay until the goose is able to fly again.

LESSON: If we have as much sense as the geese with teamwork, we'll stand by each other like that.
